

WAIVER

_____ (“Sub-Contractor”) hereby waives all claims of liability, both present and future, against _____ (“Repair Shop”) arising when Sub-Contractor enters the premises of the Repair Shop, either at the request of the Repair Shop or at the direction of a third-party, to perform repairs or other work on an automobile. As part of an Insurance Company repair program, an Insurance Company may require pre-approved Sub-Contractors, other than the Repair Shop, to enter the premises of the Repair Shop and perform work as specified in a separate contract between the Insurance Company and the Sub-Contractor. The work performed under the contract between either the Insurance Company and the Sub-Contractor or the Repair Shop and the Sub-Contractor will be performed solely by the Sub-Contractor, on the premises of the Repair Shop, without any assistance or supervision from the Repair Shop. The Repair Shop will not subsequently inspect or approve any work completed by the Sub-Contractor. The Sub-Contractor agrees to waive all liability that may potentially arise against the Repair Shop as a result of the work performed by the Sub-Contractor. All work performed by the Sub-Contractor on the premises of the Repair Shop and as agreed upon by the Insurance Company and the Sub-Contractor or the Repair Shop and the Sub-Contractor is covered under this waiver.
