1. Scholarship awards will be in the amount of \$1,000 and can be used towards tuition or tools.
2. Scholarships are available to full-time students entering their first year or second year of an ASE-accredited auto service or collision repair program.
3. To be eligible for scholarships, college applicants must be in good standing in their program, making satisfactory progress, and attending regularly.
4. Factors considered by the scholarship committee include scholastic achievement, education and career goals, financial need, special circumstances, and written recommendations.
5. All scholarship recipients will be notified by mail no later than April 30, 2021.
6. First-year scholarships will be distributed in January, 2022, for use in the second semester of program. Scholarships will be forfeited if not claimed prior to February 28, 2022.
7. Second-year scholarships will be distributed in August, 2021, for use in the first semester of program. Scholarships will be forfeited if not claimed prior to December 31, 2021.
8. All information provided in this application will be handled in a professional and confidential manner by the selection committee.
