- 1. Scholarship awards will be in the amount of \$1,000 and can be used towards tuition or tools.
- 2. Scholarships are available to full-time students entering their first year or second year of an ASE-accredited auto service or collision repair program.
- 3. To be eligible for scholarships, college applicants must be in good standing in their program, making satisfactory progress, and attending regularly.
- 4. Factors considered by the scholarship committee include scholastic achievement, education and career goals, financial need, special circumstances, and written recommendations.
- 5. All scholarship recipients will be notified by mail no later than April 30, 2021.
- 6. First-year scholarships will be distributed in January, 2022, for use in the second semester of program. Scholarships will be forfeited if not claimed prior to February 28, 2022.
- 7. Second-year scholarships will be distributed in August, 2021, for use in the first semester of program. Scholarships will be forfeited if not claimed prior to December 31, 2021.
- 8. All information provided in this application will be handled in a professional and confidential manner by the selection committee.
